

All-Star Calf Roping

Dear Ropers,

This letter is to inform both newcomers and veterans of Rising Stars ALL-STAR Calf Roping that we have a few changes starting this year. We feel these new changes will be better for you the roper as well as the overall event.

We are going to limit the ALL-STAR Roping to 75 total contestants. This will allow us as the producers to know exactly how many calves will be needed before the event and to have them prepared correctly. We will have 80 head of calves, one calf for each roper meaning no reruns plus a pen of 5 extras to replace any cripples. The calves this year will <u>NOT</u> be fresh. Each calf will have a minimum of 3 tiedown runs prior to the event as well as tied from the chute and ran through at the Lazy E Arena.

We also have a slight change in format this year. The format will consist of 3 full go rounds and average, with 1st and 2nd place in each go round along with the top 6 in the average, for a total of 12, advancing to the All-Star Shoot Out! These 12 ropers will start with a clean slate and each rope 1 calf with the top 6 advancing to the final round. The top 6 will then rope 1 more calf with the average on the 2 head determining our All-Star Shoot Out Champion.

We will once again be awarding the prestigious custom Billy Hogg Saddle, valued at \$6000. to the Shoot Out Champion. A Billy Hogg Rope Can will be awarded for the overall fastest calf and Embrace Victory Rope Can for the 3 Head Average Champion. Also we will have additional prizes such as CSI Performance Pads, Twisted X Boots, American Hat Certificates and Willard Piggin Strings!!!

Qualifying Rules for the All-Star Shoot Out:

- You must be 1st or 2nd in a go round or top 6 in the average; all splits will be taken. However, if a top two round winner is also a top 6 in the average winner, we will drop down to the next place in the average with a total of 12 ropers plus splits qualifying for the All-Star Shoot Out.
- Rising Stars All-Star Calf Roping is scheduled for November 28th, 2020 at the Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, OK. Calcutta will be sold at 4:00pm sharp with opening ceremonies and the first go round immediately following.
- ★ We have sent out 150 letters/entry forms with only the first 75 entries being guaranteed a position and a shot at over \$40,000 in cash and prizes! Entry fees will be \$600 and due by November 2nd, 2020. You have the option to mail in this form with a personal check or can enter online with a debit or credit card. (risingstarsevents.org)

★ Again this year!

Rising Stars ALL-STAR Calf Roping will be an American Qualifier as well as a WCRA Win You're In Event!! The American positions awarded will be determined by the initial 3 head average and the number of positions awarded will be determined by the number of entries in the American Side Pot based on the scale provided by RFD-TV the American. American Side Pot fee is \$500. (Optional)
